## **Who We Are**

### ***Who is Friends of Daisy Mountain Trails?***

FDMT is an authorized charitable organization [501(c)(3)]. Our mission is to establish and maintain a safe and scenic public trail system on Daisy Mountain for hikers, mountain bikers and equestrians, with connections to other formal trails.

### ***What do you do? What is the plan?***

We are comprised of a volunteer Board of Directors which is assisted by other interested individuals and organizations. The plan is to establish trail heads for access to Daisy Mountain and to maintain a system of trails for recreational use.

### ***Why should I be interested?***

Daisy Mountain is mostly State Trust land. There is a misconception that this designation is the equivalent to a State Park. That is not true and Daisy Mountain is actually subject to sale by the State to qualified interested parties which may have plans for development of the area. The establishment of formal and approved trails on the mountain will insure the availability of recreational opportunities for the future and might also assist in the overall preservation of the larger area for public use.

### ***Who is involved?***

The Friends of Daisy Mountain Trails is seeking to establish formal relationships with Maricopa County and the Maricopa County Parks and Recreation Department. We currently have working relationships with the Maricopa Trail and Parks Foundation, the New River/Desert Hills Community Association, the Anthem Community Council and with several other local community groups.
